

**LIBERTY TOWNSHIP IS ACCEPTING BIDS FOR
2022-2023 SNOW PLOWING SEASON**

- A. Bids to be submitted on or before Monday November 7, 2022 by 4:00 pm.
- B. The bidder shall provide liability insurance in the amount of \$100,000.00 per each occurrence
- C. The Township may request evidence of ability to perform work being bid.
- D. Each bidder shall be held to have examined all sites of the proposed work and adjacent areas in order to arrive at a clear understanding of the condition under which the work is to be performed. No allowance or extra consideration shall be allowed by reason of error, negligence, oversight or carelessness by the contractor.

SPECIFICATIONS

Property to be maintained as follows:

- A. Township Office, 101 W. Liberty Road, Clarklake MI
- B. Township Fire Department, 202 E. Liberty Road, Clarklake, MI
- C. Township Fire Department, 1205 Lindsey Road, Clarklake, MI

The contractor shall furnish all of the tools and equipment necessary to perform the services rendered.

Parking and drive areas at the Township Office to be plowed when snow accumulates to one inch or more.

Parking and drive areas of both Fire Department Building to be plowed when snow accumulates to two (2) inch or more.

Snow removal from handicap ramp alongside Township office to be cleared every time snow is plowed.

The Township Board will be advised of the bids received by the deadline.

The Township reserves the right to accept or reject any bids(s) or part thereof, to waive defects or irregularities and to accept the bid it deems is in the best interest of the Township.

The Township is not required to accept the lowest bid.

The successful bidder will be required to sign a contract on forms provided by the Township with ten (10) days of notification of the bid award.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE

The amount of the contract will be divided into two (2) equal payments.

The first payment will be in December 2022 with the final payment to be made March 2023.

Final Payment to be made after parking lot abutments are reinstalled to their proper positions and all gravel/foreign debris disturbed by plowing are removed from all grass areas.
